



## Snowman Muffin Candles

*Next to blueberry and banana nut, these are the best "muffins" you can make! Light this fun candle centerpiece in your kitchen — and don't worry, these snowmen are meant to melt!*

### MATERIALS

- ☐ Six-cup muffin pan, 7"x10½".
- ☐ Candle wax\*:  
crystal, 1 lb. package;  
decorative liquid, one bottle  
each: black, orange, red, blue,  
green, yellow.
- ☐ Wicks with clips\*, 3" long, six.
- ☐ White acrylic paint.

# Frosty 6-pack

**Finished Size:** 7"x10½"

**Time:** less than 1 hour (not including cooling time)

Wash and dry muffin tin. Follow manufacturer's instructions to melt crystal wax. Pour enough wax into each muffin cup to cover bottom; place base of wick into wax in each cup; let cool.

Remelt remaining wax and slowly pour into cups. (Note: Keep wax level consistent.) Let cool three hours.

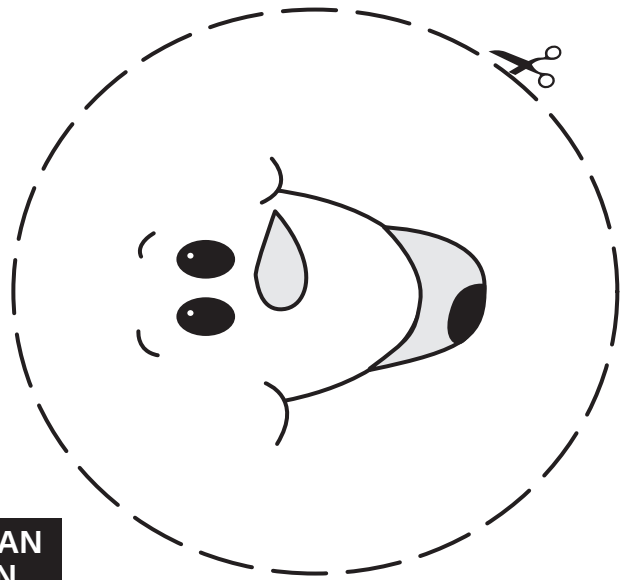
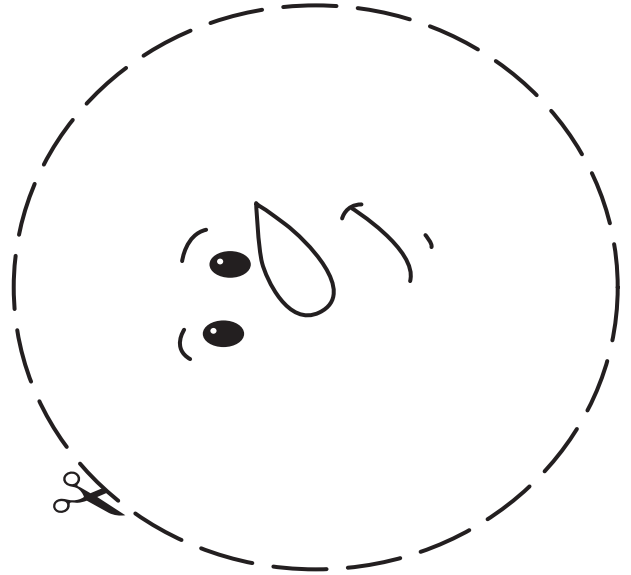
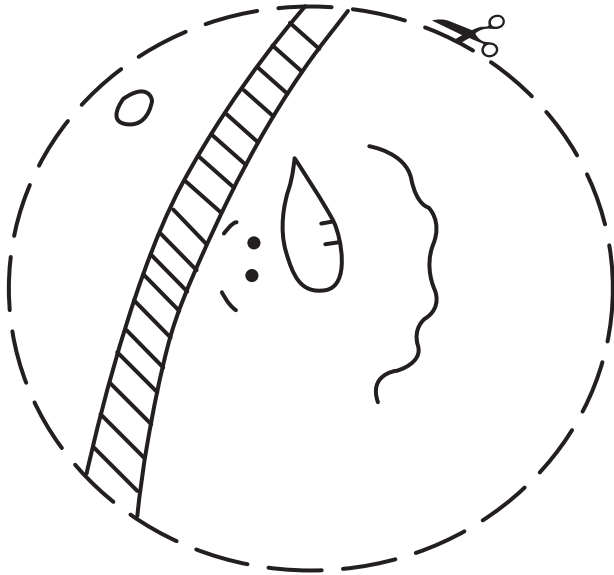
Sponge paint top of pan white. (Note: If using

a non/stick pan, paint will bead up and dry with a spatter effect. Using a regular pan will result in an overall sponged appearance.)

Cut out patterns. Using a toothpick, gently transfer facial features onto candles. (Note: Slide toothpick across top of pattern, gently pressing into candle surface.)

Using photo as guide, paint features on candles. **Quick Tip:** Practice drawing lines with liquid wax before working on candles. (Note: Liquid wax will shrink slightly while drying, so draw features a bit thicker than desired.)♥

*(Caution: Never leave a lighted candle unattended.)*
