4. Know Who You Believe In.

"For the which cause I also suffer these things: nevertheless I am not ashamed: for I know whom I have believed, and am persuaded that he is able to keep that which I have committed unto him against that day." 2 Timothy 1:12

5. Know The Greatness of God.

"I know that thou canst do every thing, and that no thought can be withholden from thee." Job 42:2

"For I know that the LORD is great, and that our Lord is above all gods." Psalm 135:5

6. Know That You Have Eternal Life.

"These things have I written unto you that believe on the name of the Son of God; that ye may know that ye have eternal life, and that ye may believe on the name of the Son of God." 1 John 5:13

7. Know God Is In Control.

"And we know that all things work together for good to them that love God, to them who are the called according to his purpose." Romans 8:28

8. Know That Christ Is Coming Back.

*"Beloved, now are we the sons of God, and it doth not yet appear what we shall be: but we know that, when he shall appear, we shall be like him; for we shall see him as he is."
1 John 3:2*
